Our **growing readership** includes practitioners, partners, funders, advocates, and community members interested in thoughtful dialogue and practical insights.

What We're Looking For – We invite submissions that are:

- Insightful, original, and relevant to our field and community
- Forward-looking, solution-oriented, or reflective of lessons learned
- Accessible to a broad professional audience (not overly technical)
- Grounded in lived experience, research, or practical application

Suggested Topics:

- Insights on emerging trends, challenges, and opportunities for our community
- Case studies, lessons learned, or innovative approaches
- Thought leadership and perspective pieces
- Community stories that highlight impact and collaboration

Tips for Strong Submissions:

- Lead with a compelling insight or story
- Offer practical value for readers
- Keep the focus clear and concise
- End with a call to action or reflection question

Submission Guidelines:

- **Length:** 400–800 words is ideal, though we can make exceptions for longer pieces
- **Tone:** Professional, engaging, and accessible
- **Format:**
 - Clear headline
 - Short introduction that hooks the reader
 - Concise paragraphs (3-5 sentences)
 - Actionable takeaways or key insights at the end (optional but encouraged)
- **Originality:** Submissions must be original and not previously published elsewhere, or clearly note if adapted
- **Citations:** Link to credible sources when referencing data or research
- **Additional:** Please include a **headshot** and a note about how you connect to Convergence

How to Submit:

- Draft article (Word or Google Doc)
- Short author bio (2–3 sentences)
- Headshot
- Suggested title and 2–3 key takeaways

Review Process:

- Editorial review for alignment with mission, clarity, and quality
- Light edits for style and length (shared with author for approval)
- Scheduled publication on our LinkedIn blog
- Promotion through our organizational channels
- Typical turnaround: 3-4 weeks from submission

Policy on AI tools:

All submitted creative work must be the original creation of the participant. If AI tools were used in a substantial or material way during the development of the submission, participants must clearly disclose this and briefly describe how AI contributed to the work.

We're excited to feature voices from across our community and showcase ideas that move our work forward.
